



## CR 101 From US 79 North of Chandler Road Fact Sheet

<b>Project Schedule:</b>	Construction to start in late 2016 and finish in early 2018
<b>Issues to be addressed:</b>	Safety and mobility improvements and roadway reconstruction

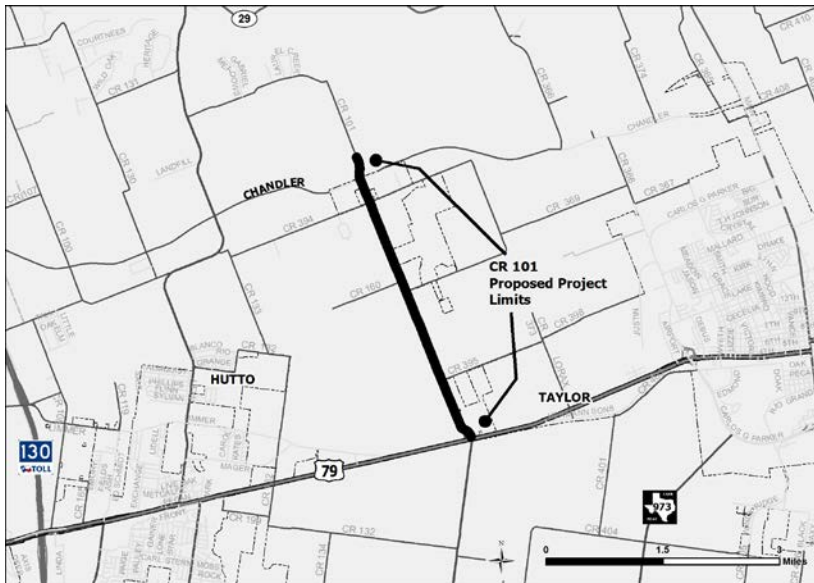
### Project Description

Williamson County, in partnership with the City of Taylor, is in the planning phases to widen and improve CR 101 from US 79 to north of Chandler Road in Taylor, Texas. Improvements will include widening the existing lanes from 11 to 12 feet and adding 10-foot wide shoulders. This roadway widening will allow for future expansion to 3 lanes with 4-foot shoulders if warranted.

### Project Need

The purpose of this proposed project is to improve safety and mobility in the area and complete roadway reconstruction. Adequate connectivity is needed in the area for an alternate north/south route between US 79 and Chandler Road.

CR 101 will remain open to traffic with one lane in each direction for the duration of the project.

### Project Funding

The City of Taylor is providing 10% of the funding with the remainder being paid for by Williamson County from the 2013 voter approved road bonds.
